



RESULTS

Soft policy instruments (informative & cooperative) dominate over hard (market-based & regulatory), though this differ by proponent types...



RESULTS

Trade-off between informational & cooperative polices with high feasibility, but weak theories of change (TOCs) and regulatory policies with low feasibility, but stronger TOCs...


